The data of this research are in the linguistic features found in the movie. The data are quantities of English taboo words that contain transcripts in the movie. The data in this research were collected by using

The results of the research show that there are 113 data and for the taboo words type of scatology is the frequently used by the characters with the rate 23,89% and the most motive used is anger and frustration with the rate 30,09%.

Wardhaugh (2014) makes reference to the fact that taboo is identified with the way of life, which is communicated in language. It implies that language is utilized to abstain from saying certain things which are considered shameless and inappropriate to the specific thing.

As indicated by Sanjaya (2018), taboo words in the form of swearing are not just articulated to communicate outrage and emotive inclination yet in addition articulated to communicate kind disposition, commonality, or character among networks.

The reason why researcher needs to utilize this movie as the object of this research is because it relates with the topic of taboo words and each character in the film regularly utilizes taboo words with one another. Types of Taboo Words

Taboo words in its utilization allude to a few employments of hostile speech. Technically, talking about taboo words is generally wishing to hurt the psychology of an individual. As indicated by Jay (1992), the utilization of taboo words is utilized exhaustively here to incorporate classes, for example, cursing, profanity, blasphemy, obscenity, vulgarity, slang, epithet, insult and slur, and scatology.

Motives of Taboo Words

As per Jay (1992), there are psychological, social, and linguistic motives in the utilization of taboo words.
